Abstract

A title page should appear in the proposal more than three or four pages. Title page should indicate the title of the project, the main organization name (and potential partners, if any), place and date of preparation of the project and the name of the donor agency which it is addressed the proposal. Project title should be short, concise and preferably refer to a specific key outcome of the project or its main business. Titles that are too long or too general fail to suggest the reader that contains the project. If your proposal is more than 10 pages, it is good to include a table of contents at the beginning or end of the document. Page content helps readers to easily find relevant document appears. This page should contain the title and beginning page number of each section of the proposal.
